The conditional uses the future stems plus the conditional endings.

Endings:

Au cas où, uncertainty, future of the past, If clauses (what *would* happen if something else *were to occur*)

Translations:

I would like to see you tonight.

Would you (vous) have a pencil?

Could (may) I speak to Dominque?

You should eat more peas.

We could go out to the movies.

Bring your book in case we have time to study.

Michel said that he would drive me to school.

He thought that we would arrive earlier.

If I were you, I'd wear a coat when it's cold.

We could eat at the restaurant if you arrive before us.
