L'examen oral final

- 1. Create a group of 2-4 people and choose from among the situations below.
- 2. Write up a script and hand it in to me by November 19. I will make comments for correction and return it to you after Thanksgiving Break.
- 3. Be sure that no ONE person writes the entire script. It should be a group effort with each person in your group making his/her <u>individual</u> contribution by writing their own obvious portion. Each individual will receive a grade on their writing portion.
- 4. If there are corrections to be made, they should be handed in to me by November 30 in order to be returned by December 2.
- 5. Groups will perform their scripts (minimum 4-5 minutes) in front of the class during December 6 and 7. Class attendance is MANDATORY for all during these two days.
- 6. Strong emphasis in grading will be placed on students' clear articulation and memorization of their part, using their very best French <u>pronunciation</u> and <u>grammar</u> (trying hard to use the French R and the correct vowel sounds, and not pronouncing the ends of words). Students will also be graded on creativity in presentation of their script, as well as the success of the presentation as a whole.
